This official application allows you to be considered for the FUNDET Hispanic/Latino Scholarship program at the Salt Lake Community College/School of Applied Technology (SAT). The financial assistance is for technical training with the SAT. Please read the instructions carefully to ensure that the scholarship criteria, requirements, and guidelines are standards that you can abide with and meet your expectations.

FUNDET is a private foundation committed to assist Hispanic adults in obtaining a technical certificate to prepare them to enter the workforce. **Be advised that the FUNDET Hispanic Scholarship program is managed by the FUNDET Student Leadership Council.** To be considered for this scholarship you must comply with the following criteria:

- Be a Hispanics/Latino adult interested in receiving a technical training to enter the workforce.
 - Commit to complete the training program.
 - Must have 10th grade level proficiency in English and Math
 - Must pay registration fees, 25% of program tuition and fees plus books, and supplies.
 - Maintain 80% attendance and 80% progress each month for the length of the program.
 - Commit to 10 hours of community service each month for the length of the program.
 - Student will attend a monthly progress interview with a member of the Student Council.

The Scholarship Process

To complete the FUNDET Scholarship process you must submit the following documentation at the initial interview:

- A signed FUNDET Hispanic Scholarship Application form
- A signed Release of Information form
- FUNDET Interview Questions
- Employment Form (Past and present employment only)
- Personal essay that includes your interest in the chosen training program, why you feel you deserve the scholarship, your career and employment objectives.
- Personal demographics information
- Two letters of recommendation
- Progress and Attendance reports

The final interview for the scholarship approval will be conducted by a member of the FUNDET Executive Board. Once you have complied with your financial contribution, met the requirements and submitted the documentation; the decision will be made within in 24 hours. Please allow two weeks for the official award letter.

By signing the FUNDET Scholarship Application form, you are committing to adhere to the policies and procedures as stated in the scholarship application disclosure.
